FINANCIAL UPDATE

Pledges budgeted	\$32,500	\$162,500	\$35,167
Pledges received	\$25,457	\$139,299	\$62,380
Difference	-\$ 7,043	-\$ 23,201	\$27,213

The pledges received for May were down from budget by -\$7,043. We are also down from last year May by -\$23,201. YTD we are down by -\$23,202 from budget and are down from last YTD by -\$39,493. Non-pledge dollars are still ahead of budget by \$260 and ahead of last year by approximately \$1,700

Total income was down -\$5,090 from budget and YTD down by -\$23,784; \$10,000 of that is from non-payment of Listos but we will be receiving those funds in July.

May expenses were under budget by \$2,739 and under the year by \$15,711.

In comparison to last year's expenses, we are over by \$6,719 but still under last year day to day by \$10,080.

Bottom line, our May budget was over by \$2,350 and over YTD by \$8.071. Compared to last May, we are down by \$38,828 for the month and down YTD last May by \$21,842.
