#### <u>Fire Update</u>

Here we are....almost a year out from the devasting fire on Easter Monday morning. Hope IS growing here and the excitement has been building for when we will once again have our building in full use—for our ministries and sharing the space with our Community. The only thing that will be stopping us is the HVAC system (which was ordered 2 weeks after the fire) arriving. Supply chain issues have tested our patience and progress—and we are told that the new AC units will be here in May. Until then, we won't be able to take full occupancy of the north side.

Look inside for the details of our all-church dinner and celebration on Saturday, April 22. The construction crews have been busy working to finish everything and their hard work is making the north side take shape. This next month and a half will focus on purchasing replacement items, especially for Listos Preschool and Childcare who plan to move back in August. Spring is coming, hope is growing, and our church home is almost rebuilt. We are truly blessed! Here are some of the key updates that have occurred:

- Furniture has been moved back into (and some purchased) the Peace Room
- Listos stairwell finished with drywall and painted (vs the brick that wasn't very appealing even after cleaning/ painting)
- Flooring continues to be installed in the North end
- Remaining fixtures added to the restrooms in the North end
- All cabinets in North end installed (except one that will still be coming)

## FINANCIAL UPDATE

Difference	\$ 2,167	\$ 2,503	\$9,211

Pledges for February were good (\$2,167); ahead of budget which also puts us ahead for the year's budget by \$2,503. We had a very good February 2022, so we didn't beat those numbers, but we're off to a good start!

Our total income was down from budget by only -\$98, but we have yet to receive any Listos rent money. YTD we are ahead of budget by \$264 even without Listos rent. Compared to last year, we are down for the month by -\$10,364 and down YTD by -\$1,817.

Our expense control is \$11,488 less than budget and \$16,610 below budget YTD.

Net Income for the month is \$11,389 better than budget and \$16,874 better than budget. Compared to last year, we are \$3,449 better for the month and \$25,848 better than last year's bottom line.

All in all we are doing good. We just need to keep the momentum going and we'll remain in good shape for the year.
