- **Items can be dropped off now through March 15th.** Our auction dates will run starting March 30 – April 8, 2019 (6pm cutoff).

- Minimum bid is \$5 for all items, however, you may specify a higher price when dropping items off. Register on-line as a bidder anytime between now and the auction. There is a 10% buyer’s premium on all winning bids.
- Items accepted for auction include: personal property, antiques, collectibles, jewelry, furniture, coins and currency, tools, vehicles, construction equipment, farm machinery, recreational equipment, office supplies and furniture, anything of value.
